Gateways Part 2 – Trusting God

Discussion Starter

Ask the students how their week went. Are there things your students want to pray about?

Discussion Questions

- Q1. What is the hardest thing to trust God with in your life?
- Q2. Why do you think it is hard to trust God? Why do we doubt him so much?
- Q3. Do you believe that God loves you? Explain why or why not.

Read Psalm 25:1-10

- Q4. Do you believe that God is completely (100%) good? Explain why or why not.
- Q5. Is God trustworthy? If so, what does it look like to actually trust Him with your life?
- Q6. The Psalmist shows great humility in his attitude towards God. Explain how we see his humility expressed in his writing.
- Q7. How is humility linked to trusting God? What does pride do to our ability to trust God?
- Q8. Has the talk from Pastor Chris and this study helped you to trust God more? Explain.
- Q9. What are some small practical things you can do to start to trust God more in your life?

Bible Passages for Fusion Discussion

Psalm 25:1-10 (NLT)

- ¹ O Lord, I give my life to you.
² I trust in you, my God!
 Do not let me be disgraced,
 or let my enemies rejoice in my defeat.
³ No one who trusts in you will ever be disgraced,
 but disgrace comes to those who try to deceive others.
⁴ Show me the right path, O Lord;
 point out the road for me to follow.
⁵ Lead me by your truth and teach me,
 for you are the God who saves me.
 All day long I put my hope in you.
⁶ Remember, O Lord, your compassion and unfailing love,
 which you have shown from long ages past.
⁷ Do not remember the rebellious sins of my youth.
 Remember me in the light of your unfailing love,
 for you are merciful, O Lord.
⁸ The Lord is good and does what is right;
 he shows the proper path to those who go astray.
⁹ He leads the humble in doing right,
 teaching them his way.
¹⁰ The Lord leads with unfailing love and faithfulness
 all who keep his covenant and obey his demands.
